 Need to get work done on the backup sump pump. The control panel seems to be broken. Zuiko will call Grainger about this in January.

#### Projects needing attention

- Peeling paint on the wall of the bathroom cabinet.
- Caulk discussion room ceiling.
- Install new email program on the desktop.

#### Finished projects

- Myoho has developed a list of things we should be doing for work on Sundays and work days. This creates a framework we can add things to – if you see something that needs doing, let her know. She passed a draft version out to us and attendees suggested a few tweaks.
- Follow-up on thermostat We seem to be saving a bit. I compared our gas bills for December 2017 and March, 2017, when the average temperature was 36 degrees. We paid \$2.71 per day in December, and \$2.93 per day in March. I didn't compare our electric bills because we have too many other electrical appliances. I am usually the only one using the stove and hot water and my usage doesn't vary much by month.
- Phone service update We will now be getting 12 mbps of connectivity and phone service for \$89.99 for the next 12 months. The price will then rise to \$109.99. At that point it looks as if we can call in again, get the newest package, and get our rate reduced again. (confirmation number – C77599142)

#### New projects

- Fix ceiling in bathroom and probably Zuiko's sitting room. The plaster is falling down. Zuiko suggests contacting Roger Brecht who did the kitchen for us for an estimate and possible work.
- Replace rail on concrete steps Julie will investigate materials/boards.
- Paint the porch deck.
- Paint the side of the bathroom cabinet next to the kitchen wall. Kelly noticed that the paint is flaking.

### Pending long-term projects – Things that need to get done sometime

- Painting Woodwork and walls in library, hall, office, Zuiko's room, and stairwell / touch up garage / touch up porch.
- Roof Long-term plan is to put on a new roof in 2019 or 2020.
- Refinish floors Would be nice to begin with the zendo and the entry.
- Possible finishing of basement corner into discussion/class space.
- Sealing of basement against moisture
- Garage door may need replacement in the next few years
